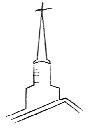


Missions

**Sanctity of Human Life: Origin of Our Lives**

Dr. King A. Counts

**Genesis: 1:24-31**

**Introduction: Al Mohler writes:** “The New Testament clearly establishes the Gospel of Jesus Christ upon the foundation of the Bible’s account of creation. If there was no historical Adam and no historical Fall, the Gospel is no longer understood in biblical terms.”

Human life is a miracle of our God and the key to a true world view.

God created all things.  
God created humans in His image.  
God gave human beings dominion

Conclusion: The Genesis account of human life is the heart of the Scriptures. Daniel Dennett refers to Evolution as "The Universal Acid" which can eat through anything including whatever container tries to hold it. “It eats through just about every traditional concept and leaves in its wake a revolutionized world-view with much of the old landmarks still recognizable, but transformed in fundamental ways." (*Darwin's Dangerous Idea*)
