Dear friends.

I am scheduled to leave on Saturday on a long series of travels with a small team (Terry Dalrymple, Jeff Bisgrove, and myself) from the Global CHE Network. (Zihuatanejo to Phoenix to Accra, Ghana to Nairobi, Kenya to Chiang Mai, Thailand to Managua, Nicaragua). Our purpose is to hold a series of Founders Meetings with people working in community health evangelism ministries around the world, to help bring them together with a common vision. I am also scheduled to teach mini-seminars at a Transformational Development Conference in Ghana.

But my travels are now in question, since the visas (and my passport) have not arrived. The visas were to be sent from Washington, D.C., but that office is probably buried in the snowstorm.

The visas could arrive tomorrow. Or they may not. It is in the Lord's hands.

Please be praying:

1. That the meetings may be a blessing and an encouragement to all the CHE teams that attend. Pray that this will help to develop a common vision and a strategy to work closely together.
2. Pray for each of the teams (Ghana, Kenya, Thailand, Nicaragua) preparing the meetings--that the Lord will richly bless their efforts.
3. Pray for safety in travel for all those who are attending, from many directions.
4. Pray, as Paul did, that "Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ." (Philippians 1:27)
5. God will carry through his purposes. Pray that I may fully trust in him to work this out, and to carry us through all the travels. Thank God that he knows what is happening, even when I don't.
6. Pray for God's wisdom and his strength in all that we do, and that this may bring glory to him.

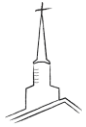
