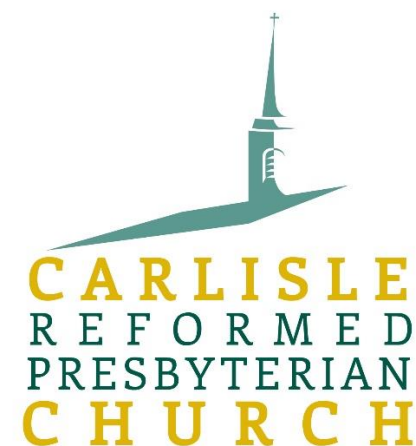


- Mission** We exist to glorify and enjoy the triune God of Scripture through worship, nurture, and witness.
